



THE SWEDISH ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP FOR THE MASTER IN INTERNATIONAL COMMERCIAL ARBITRATION LAW PROGRAM

The Swedish Arbitration Association (SAA) is a non-profit organization that promotes the practice and study of arbitration in Sweden. Through its range of activities and its extensive international network it provides a platform for expanding and exchanging knowledge and experience for improving arbitration practice and enhancing Sweden as an international leader in the field.

The SAA offers one full-tuition scholarship for the academic year 2017-2018 to one law graduate from a non-EU/EEA country to participate in the Master of Laws in International Commercial Arbitration Law programme at Stockholm University ("the ICAL programme").

General information on the application process

1. Eligible students

Applicants from countries outside the EU/EEA and Switzerland and who are required to pay tuition fees.

To be eligible for the scholarship, applicants must meet all the entry requirements for the admission to the ICAL programme. Find out more information about the entry requirements and the scholarship application form here: <u>www.jurinst.su.se/master</u>.

2. How to apply

Complete and submit the <u>online Application Form</u>. There is no need to provide any supporting documents with the application form, as we will receive the supporting documents directly from our Admissions Department.



Scholarship applicants must also separately apply to the Master of Laws in International Commercial Arbitration Law program through the University admissions website, <u>www.universityadmissions.se.</u> Applications may be made **until 16 January 2017**

The deadline for scholarship applications is also **16 January 2017**.

3. Application process

Applications will be reviewed upon receipt and shortlisted candidates will be considered throughout Spring 2017. Successful scholarship applicants will be contacted in Spring 2017.

The scholarship will be awarded to the most exceptional applicant based on merits.

Due to the volume of applications and interest that we receive, we are unable to notify all applicants of the result of their applications or to provide feedback on individual applications. Applicants who do not receive an answer from Stockholm University by the end of June 2017, shall assume that their scholarship application has been unsuccessful.

The SAA Scholarship covers the tuition fee for the 2017-2018 academic year, which means that it does not cover travel, living or other costs/expenses.

The scholarship is valid for the academic year 2017-2018 and cannot be deferred. Applicants that wish to delay their studies must reapply for the scholarship.
